

The US State Department, via its embassies, acts in unethical, unlawful (even by its own laws), and deceptive means to block lawful renunciation of US citizenship done in a standard manner with proper paperwork and requirements met.

I have the vast majority of this in email communication and written confirmation with them, however some I do not as what happens in their offices is not allowed to be recorded. In the eight years I have dealt with them regarding my citizenship renunciation, they have:

2018

1. They conned me into getting a passport instead (they said "they use the passport form for everything including renunciations")
2. They sent a vague email on December 31st, 2018, during a holiday, closing the case.
3. They refused to respond after sending that office holiday party-timed email.

2019

1. They kept my new passport they ordered for themselves, did not destroy it after the 30 days they have under their own laws, and kept it valid for multiple years

2023

1. They blocked the second application from going through based on that passport being missing
2. The offices in charge of policing them refused to respond or help in the investigation to uncover how the passport went missing and stayed missing in their custody, despite the embassy claiming that it being missing required me to fill out a form that demanded the substantiation of an investigation by policing authorities into missing and stolen passports.
3. They used various hazing throughout all of this.
4. They attempted to take the equivalent of \$2350 USD in cash without providing a receipt while I was in the consulate. I demanded and demanded and refused to leave the counter until the receipt was provided, despite them telling me multiple times that their "not providing a receipt is normal."
5. They demanded I perjure myself.
6. They demanded I fill in another passport application to "finish" the second renunciation attempt after I had already paid and given the oath of renunciation. I declined that demand because it would nullify the oath of renunciation.
7. They then claimed they sent the forms to the US for processing and went silent for two years.

2025

1. They never sent the oath of renunciation to the US to be processed, and instead demanded that I go to their office again to sign a second oath or "they would stop the proceedings."

I declined the demand because I have already sworn the oath in their office, paid the money, and done my side of the obligations.

2. They did the above numbered behaviour by sending an email on December 23rd at 3 pm, again during holiday office party time, on the eve of a holiday season in an office that celebrates that holiday, attempting to close the case due to "not taking the oath twice."

Etc.

I was illegally adopted or otherwise similarly illegally procured, by a US worker/citizen, from Cárcel de Devoto in Buenos Aires, Argentina where I was detained with my mother during one of the US interventions in South America in 1980. I spent most of my childhood in the US begging to go home to my mother (who was presumed to be in Argentina). I have not lived in or visited the US since 2011. I have a second citizenship on the documents, and a third one from birth - still unpapered due to the State terrorism turmoil I was procured from. After a lifetime of attempting to untangle myself via ordinary means that do not seem to actually exist (i.e. removing illegally procured citizenship from a child trafficking victim asking for the removal of it by choice), and physically removing myself from the US and attaining a third citizenship. I chose to go through the only open bureaucratic route to end my association to them - formal paid renunciation of US citizenship.

I would like my freedom from the US.

Also, after seeing how few renunciations go through, and how adeptly the embassy workers used various cons on me, and attempted cons, it would appear that they are maliciously blocking renunciation applications from going through on a regular basis. They are simply too practiced in what they do.

I would hope that we have the right to separate ourselves from an unhealthy and oppressive country we are no longer residents of and do not live in the jurisdiction of. And that the US State Department criminal maliciousness is not simply accepted as ordinary because of its nation's deceptive advertising, financial control, and war campaigns.

I seek protection for myself and my family, and a path to renunciation for us as well as for all the others who the criminal State has silenced and bamboozled.

I can send documents if you read this and respond. Until then, I have lost all hope after a lifetime of trying to escape an unwanted situation, in the hands of aggressive and overbearing strangers and their enablers and authorities. I have come to realize everything I write goes unread, unheard, and uncared for because of hatred of "others" and the misguided belief that being sold to an exploitative military state as a child is "a gift" and remaining forcibly bureaucratically chained to it and obligated to it is an "opportunity."
